Players Code of Conduct Agreement

As a San Diego All-Stars player, I agree to this Players Code of Conduct Agreement for the San Diego All-Stars basketball club:

1. Players **must be on time** for all San Diego All-Stars practices and team fundraising events.
2. Reports cards/progress reports must be turned in at the next scheduled practice or game.
3. All players must respect each other, coaches, family members, and staff at gyms, school and in the community.
4. If grades or attitudes drop below average, players will be benched until grades or attitudes have improved.
5. No alcohol or drugs will be tolerated.
6. All players must respect all facilities that are used by the San Diego All-Stars teams.
7. No gang colors, words or signs will be tolerated.

Failure to follow the Players Code of Conduct may result in the player being dismissed from the San Diego All-Stars team. If a player is dismissed or quits the San Diego All-Stars team prior to the end of the season, they will be required to return their uniform and will not be entitled to a refund of membership fees or other prepaid expenses.

San Diego All-Stars Rules and Policies

1. **All players** must stay eligible. All players must maintain a “C” average in school to participate in any games. Any player that is not eligible can practice, but will not play. Players who do not play are required to come and support the team.
2. **All players** must make it to practice on time. If you cannot make it to practice, you need to contact the coach three (3) hours before practice. You must have a good reason for missing practice, i.e. a lot of homework, studying for a test or no transportation. Most practices will start at 6 or 7 pm.
3. **All players** must arrive a minimum of 45 minutes before a game. If a player cannot make it to a game, please let the coach know a couple of days before the game.
4. **All players** will respect the coaching staff and his teammates. No player will be disrespectful to any adult. Any player talking back will sit out the rest of the game and face a two (2) game suspension.

San Diego All-Stars Parents Agreement

In consideration of San Diego All-Stars accepting the player named above (the “player”) into the basketball program and activities of San Diego All-Stars (“SDA”) the undersigned parent/legal guardian (“you”) of the player hereby agrees as follows:

Financial Commitment. In exchange for the services provided, you agree to pay the **monthly dues** and **tournament fees** for the spring/summer/fall sessions in which the player participates.

Monthly dues and tournament fees do not include transportation and hotel expenses. That said, SDA generally has room to provide transportation with our coaches and can also bunk players with coaches in hotels (we arrange for 3 to 4 players in the room with a coach).

When paying by check, **please write your players name and the nature of the payment (e.g. monthly dues, or “X tournament”) on the check on the memo line** so that your account is properly credited. Make checks payable to “San Diego All-Stars” or “SDA Basketball.”

SDA offers a 5% discount for upfront payment in full of all amounts due for a spring, summer or fall session. Please inquire if you are interested in doing this.

Player Information and Image on Internet. You acknowledge that information and images/video of all SDA players will appear on the Internet at www.sdabasketball.com, including name, age, high school, hometown and other information necessary to promote the player to scouts and college coaches. SDA will not display player’s mailing address, parents/guardian name or email address, parent phone number, player’s phone number, player’s shoe size or uniform size. Posting of GPA is optional, but recommended. You hereby grant permission to include this information and images/video on the Internet for the player. In addition, you hereby give my permission to SDA and to its web designer, Travers Media, to use images/video of the player to advertise, promote and marketing the products/services of SDA and its web designer.

Release. You recognize the possibility of physical injury associated with the sport of basketball, including travel to and from basketball-related events. You hereby indemnify the SDA Parties from and hold each of them harmless against any and all losses, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses which any of them may suffer or incur arising out of or resulting from the player’s participation in any SDA activities or a breach by the player or any member of the family of the player of the SDA Player Code of Conduct Agreement or the SDA Rules and Policies.
